Arrival and Registration:

2-4 p.m.: Student Registration will be held from 2 to 4 p.m. on Friday in the lobby of the American Heritage Center on the Harding campus. The GPS address is 915 E. Market Avenue, Searcy, AR. There are several nearby parking lots, and directional signs will be posted. Counselors will welcome the students and guide them through the registration process. Students will be directed to their dormitory and will have time to settle in.

Students who are flying into Little Rock will be picked up by a staff member, and the group will be delivered to the American Heritage Center. <u>Flight information</u> must be emailed or faxed to the Honors Symposium office.

4 p.m.: Parents may opt to meet the Staff and Faculty in the Bell Conference Room before saying goodbye to their student.

5 p.m.: Opening dinner for students, Staff and Faculty

Departure: The last activity of Honors Symposium will be breakfast on the last Friday morning of the session. Students must be checked out of the dorm and picked up by 10 a.m. on Friday morning. Students flying from Little Rock will be shuttled as a group. Breakfast will be provided om the way to the airport.
